

Coming Soon



In mid-2025, ECU Health and Acadia Healthcare will be opening a brand new, state-of-the-art, 144-bed behavioral health hospital, centrally located in the medical district of Greenville and less than a mile from ECU Health Medical Center.

This new facility will be the largest in eastern North Carolina and will have specialty care for adults with mental illness, intellectual disabilities and dual-diagnosis disorders, and will include 24 inpatient beds dedicated to serving the behavioral health care needs of children and adolescents – the only such beds within 75 miles of Greenville. It will also provide day treatment, such as partial hospitalization and intensive outpatient care.

The psychiatric care will be provided by East Carolina University's Department of Psychiatric and Behavioral Medicine and will serve as a teaching hospital for psychiatry, social work, nursing and other behavioral health professionals – providing employment opportunities before the grand opening of the new hospital.

The modern design will include the latest safety and aesthetic features available. A gymnasium, outdoor courtyards and a fitness center will be included in the therapeutic programming.

This new facility will feature:

- 144-bed inpatient psychiatric care facility
- \$65 million investment in behavioral health care resources
- Comprehensive treatment for adults, seniors, children and adolescents
- Treatment for anxiety, depression, bipolar disorder, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and more
- 24 inpatient beds dedicated to children and adolescents
